As Spring begins to bloom around us, Prince of Peace welcome's you to Sunday Worship. Prince of Peace continues to follow all health guidelines directed by our Governor and The Ohio Department of Health. Please keep in mind that Cuyahoga County and our surrounding counties are still in the Red Zone. As the county continues to recover, the mask mandate placed on July 17th, and reinstated on Nov. 12th will still be in effect.

#### RESERVATIONS:

Prince of Peace's top priority is to create a safe and comfortable environment for members and friends to worship in. If you feel comfortable, please sign-up to worship with us for our **April 25th**, single service. We will be worshiping together at Prince of Peace at 10am. We will also be having an outdoor, socially-distanced social hour after the service with coffee and donuts. Our at-risk members are still encouraged to participate through digital worship until they are comfortable worshiping inperson. There will be a limited number of "family groups" in the sanctuary so we can maintain social-distancing (a family group is 1 to 5 people). As more is known about the health and safety considerations, we will adjust our worship opportunities.

## Prince of Peace Cares Assisted Living & Nursing Home Visitation Outreach Ministry

This activity consists of Sunday visitation to nearby Assisted Living/Nursing Home facilities where a short Communion service is held. Before the Covid 19 pandemic hit in early 2020, these visitations were taking place at Westlake Village, Arden Court, and Bickford of Rocky River. Communion kits were prepared by the Altar Guild and blessed during the 9:00 am service.

Pat and I can only speak to the visitations at Bickford of Rocky River (former Sunrise Assisted Living). In the way of a little history, Pat and I joined Prince of Peace in 2008 when our Saint Andrew Lutheran Church



closed its doors and our congregation chose to make POP our new home. The visitation program called "Saint Andrew Cares" was developed at St. Andrew and our visits began at Sunrise assisted Living. When we came to POP, we continued this ministry with volunteers each week covering a Sunday so it has been active on a weekly basis for over 25 years at this same location! As part of her work as Congregational Care Coordinator, Judy Kazak provided coordination of the visitation volunteers. Other Bickford volunteers included Barb Fronczak, Patty Beard, Judy Rolik, as well Judy Kazak.

At Bickford (Sunrise), the Communion service was held in the Alzheimer's wing. Attendance would range from two or three to as many as ten or twelve, usually based on the willingness of the staff to gather the residents. Many times we had to go and do personal invitations, helping with walkers, wheel chairs, etc. Both of our mothers had forms of dementia so we were knowledgeable of the challenges associated with this condition.

At the beginning of our time together, we just spent some time talking about things happening in our lives. Loneliness is a bitter pill to swallow in these conditions and we found that spending a few minutes in these general conversations focused their attention. Short term memory may be lacking but we were often amazed at the earlier life recollections. We sometimes read very short stories of books borrowed from the Sunday school library. The actual service was read from a bulletin that was the same each time except for the reading of the Gospel. There were sometimes interruptions of all types, some got up and walked out, some needed to get their meds, some even fell asleep even though the service reading only lasted about fifteen minutes. When it came time to say the Lords Prayer, we were always amazed that most were still able to say the prayer with us. Of course the Catholic members omitted the last sentence!

Communion was distributed using the host and grape juice from the kit. At the end of the service, we would go around the room and shake their hand and thank them for attending. This was one of the most emotional times for us as we looked into their eyes and saw the gratitude for our visit! One highlight of one of our visits was presenting a quilt to each person attending that Sunday. These were provided by our Prince of Peace Comfort Quilters. The smiles on their faces were heart warming and very touching!

Over the years we have been involved with this ministry we have become friends with these souls as they approach the end of their lives. We always make sure to remind them that the best is yet to come!
