Sign Up to Join Us for In-Person Worship Service ~ This Sunday, August 2, 2020

Hello members of Prince of Peace,

In this ever changing world we try our best to create a safe environment for all. Prince of Peace is following all health guidelines directed by our Governor and The Ohio Department of Health. Cuyahoga County is still marked as a Level 3 Red Alert, meaning that Cuyahoga has hit 4-5 of DeWine's risk indicators. Due to continuing in the Red Zone, beginning on July 17th, face masks are now required by all to be worn in public areas.

We understand that these times are hard and that many people have yet to feel comfortable being in a group setting, however for anyone who does feel comfortable returning, we hope to see you this **Sunday, August 2nd** for our one, in-person service at 10:00 am. Our at-risk members are still encouraged to participate through digital worship until they are comfortable worshipping in-person. There will be a limited number of "family groups" in the sanctuary so we can maintain social-distancing (a family group is 1 to 5 people).

We will not be singing in initial worship services. Individual communion kits will be offered. If the number of people wishing to attend exceeds the distancing layout, we will develop additional worship options. Please be flexible as we adapt to these new conditions. As more is known about the health and safety considerations, we will adjust our worship opportunities.

Sit as a family group in areas marked "Seating Here" Seating available for young families in narthex. No nursery available. Wear your mask please (exception for young children). Masks will be available from the ushers if you forget. Arrive early so we can maintain social distancing before service. Leave as a family group and exit to parking lot where you can socialize and maintain appropriate distance

RESERVATIONS: There are 19 family group spots on [SignUpGenius](#). Sign-ups are available through **Thursday, July 30 at 11:59pm**. A family group ranges from 1-5 people. If a family group has more than five, that family will need to reserve two different family group spots to cover their whole family. Please make sure to check that the date you are signing up for is **August 2nd**. 1) Scroll down to date **08/02/2020**. 2) Click the box that says "Sign Up", a check mark should indicate that it has been chosen. 3) Once box is marked, click "Submit and Sign Up" button 4) Fill in you First and Last name, and in the comment box with the number of people you plan to attend, and if you need specific seating due to hard of hearing/vision, or preference. 5) Once everything is filled in click "Sign Up Now".

**If you have any complications or questions please call the church office. If no one can pick up the phone at the time of your call, please leave a message and we will get back to you as soon as we can.*

Phone Reservations: For those who do not have access to a computer or smartphone there are five family group spots available for reservations by phone. To reserve your spot please call the office at 440/871-5565. Please leave a voicemail with your groups first and last name, the total amount of people in your group, and your phone number (so we can call back and verify your reservation was received, or to let you know that all the call reservations have been filled).

The 2020 Virtual Synod Assembly

The 2020 Virtual Synod Assembly registration is now open. Online registration for the assembly will be open **now through August 13, 2020**. The base registration fee is \$75 per voting member. The registration fee for retired rostered leaders who are NOT currently serving a congregation and wish to register as a voting member is \$10.

Only voting members with a unique email address will be able to register. A unique email address is necessary to receive essential information about the upcoming Virtual Assembly and to receive voting access codes. For this virtual assembly, email will be the primary form of communication to all voting members, and the only way to authenticate voting members. Because of this, there will be NO late registration. If an emergency substitution of a lay voting member is necessary, there will be some ability to do so after the registration deadline; however, there will not be any ability to do so after August 31, 2020. For the month of July-September, requested items are **Peanut butter and canned meats**. The collection containers are located as you enter the Education Wing. Thank you!

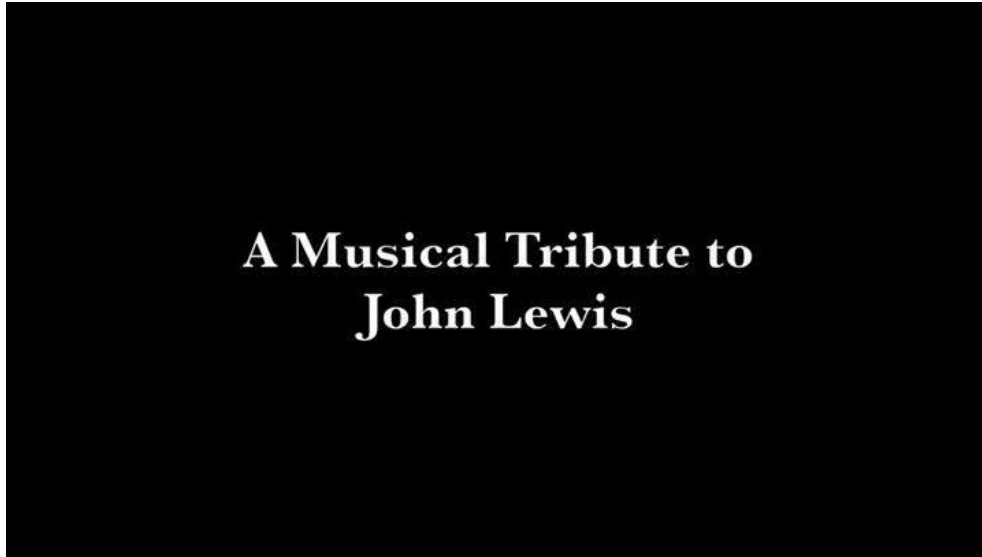
