REFLECTIONS ON MISSION, VISION, AND VALUES

Our vision invites us to **FOCUS ON YOUTH**. Why might that be so important for a thriving and vibrant church?

For one thing, our faith, from Genesis onward, is a story of the generations of humankind. Faith persists and flourishes when older generations share their story with those who follow them. In our culture, we are often segregated by age -- schools, recreational activities, retirement facilities. That's odd isn't it? A thriving community requires the presence of both its elders and its youth -- the elders to pass on their accumulated wisdom, and the youth to innovate for the future. A community consisting solely of one generation is not sustainable.

Secondly, our faith is a treasure, and treasures are gifts to younger generations. If you are an elder, then you know that gifts to the next generation -- of values, of money, of property, of plans -- require intentionality. The same is true of faith. And if you are younger, then you may be growing in awareness that treasures from your parents and grandparents are not offers to be taken for granted but are part of their hope for you and your own children. When the Psalmist tells us to "rejoice and be glad" -- that's a command for all generations!
