
SAVE THE DATE! Sleep In Heavenly Peace Delivery Date is Saturday, June 21st. Will need 16 adult or high school age








## Food Bank Help Day




Construction Cost\* = \$533,149



Psalm 130

Waiting for Divine Redemption

A Song of Ascents.

1 Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord.

2 Lord, hear my voice!

Let your ears be attentive

Waiting for the world to change.

...just to name a few.

And now you have these songs running through your head for the rest of the day. You're welcome!

We are in a time of waiting. A time in the wilderness, not knowing when this time will end, and something new begins.

Waiting.

Psalm 130, another psalm of ascents, ties the waiting for the Lord with hope.

5 I wait for the Lord, my soul waits,

and in his word I hope;

In his word, I hope.

Let us continue to find hope in the Word of God, reminding us that our waiting is not in vain.

I am reminded of these words – I don't remember who said them, but I find it to be a good reminder.

"God may not always be on our schedule, but God is always right on time."

God's ways are not our ways.

And God WILL make a way.

God is with us, even in the waiting.

Christ has died, Christ is risen and Christ WILL come again.

Let us pray:

O God, we wait. Wait with us. Give us patience. Give us hope. We pray this in the name of your Son, our Savior and Lord. Amen


