REFLECTIONS ON MISSION, VISION, AND VALUES

A recent Atlantic Monthly article was headlined online as follows: "Escaping Poverty Requires Almost 20 Years With Nearly Nothing Going Wrong." I think that we can all imagine how difficult that would be -- even those of us who enjoy considerable affluence can be at least temporarily set back by unexpected medical bills, car or household repairs, or other expenses we did not anticipate. What if we did not benefit from many of the safety nets of family, education, and employment upon which we count?

One of the elements of our vision is SERVICE TO OTHERS – ESPECIALLY THE POOR. We know that Jesus said to his disciples, "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God." We know that Jesus also told his disciples in Mark and in Matthew that "the kingdom of heaven is at hand." If the kingdom of heaven is already among us, then it stands to reason that we are called to affirm and to further God's kingdom – by addressing the causes of poverty so prevalent in our country: racism, mass incarceration, economic policies, and disinvestment in at-risk students of all ages. What can our Social Ministries do to help all of us care and act in service to the poor?
