The Endowment Committee has announced a grant of \$3,500 from the General Endowment Fund for 2019. Interested individuals or groups can apply for ENDOWMENT FUND some or all of this grant. Grant application forms are

available on the church website. Forms must be completely filled out and turned into the church office by May 1st. After that date, the Endowment Committee will meet to review and then either accept or deny. Note that the General Endowment Fund Guidelines do not allow grants to cover normal church operating expenses.

#### REFLECTIONS ON OUR MISSION, VISION, AND VALUES

When we confirm that our values reflect the GRACE of God, we recall that the first letter of GRACE stands for "Giving of ourselves." In one of the most significant passages in the Gospels, Jesus says, in response to those who wonder when they have been attentive to him, "I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink. I was a stranger and you welcomed me. I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me."

Make a little trip down the upstairs hallway, and take a look at the donation baskets: 2100 East Lakeside Men's Shelter, Providence House, and the Women's Re-Entry Network, among many others. There are multiple ways in which we at POP can give of ourselves right here in our own building. Perhaps you could resolve to make a donation to one of the baskets every month.

In addition, this Lent might be a good season in which to stretch ourselves a bit. Talk a cue from the Helping Hands poster in the narthex, and let Judy know how you might be available to assist someone, just once or as a regular practice. Decide that this is the spring to respond to Sean's request for help in serving an LMM supper. Start making plans now to come to the OMNI event in the Fall. Make a bold move, and help with communion or worship for our folks who cannot join us on Sundays, or pick up a hammer and head to the Habitat House with our faithful builders.

Our values push us into arenas beyond ourselves and for others, and enable us to fulfill our Mission and enact our Vision.
