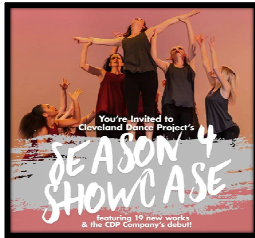
Pierstorf Memorial Loan Fund
