It will be a traditional style worship service, "Worship In the Woods".


Weekly Bible Study with Pastor Charlie

Synopsis John Ortberg "Who Is This Man?" Five Week Video Series


Jesus' impact on our world is highly unlikely, widely inescapable, largely unknown, and decidedly double-edged. It is unlikely in light of the severe limitations of his

The Chopping for Change (C4C) program is a partnership between Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry (LMM), the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (ODRC) and the Cuyahoga County Office of Reentry to provide pre-release workforce development training and behavioral health services for women in the criminal justice system.



Women incarcerated at the North East Reintegration Center (NERC) in Cleveland, Ohio, come to LMM five days a week and engage in a comprehensive program which includes counseling, support services and culinary arts training. <u>LEARN MORE</u>
