Reflection

Reflections on Mission Vision, and Values

Our vision for Prince of Peace calls upon us to create A LASTING LEGACY THROUGH STEWARDSHIP. What does that mean? Stewardship is what and who we are: people called to care for the earth, for the church, for our communities – through our time, talents, and treasure. Depending upon the time of life in which we find ourselves, we may be capable of more generosity in one of these areas than in the others. In I Peter 4:10, we are advised that “Like good stewards of the manifold grace of God, [we are to] serve one another with whatever gift each of us has received.” We should periodically pause to assess our gifts, and whether and how we are sharing them.

A lasting legacy? That phrase invites us to think long-term. In our culture, we tend to be excellent short –term thinkers and planners, but we can grow in learning to take a longer view. Think about what the world and church were like in 1989 – 30 years ago – and how many surprising changes have taken place. We stand on the shoulders of others as we worship and serve today. What do we need to do to act as good stewards for 2049? It’s mid-boggling – but it’s part of our call!
