REFLECTIONS ON OUR MISSION, VISION, AND VALUES

Nearly every week during the Children's Time in the 9:00 service, I am delighted by how easily our children are able to respond to questions about helping others. They always have ideas about sharing meals and snacks, helping others who fall down on the playground, or welcoming new children into their classrooms. I think sometimes that it is easier for children than it is for adults to practice one of our values reflecting the **GRACE** of God, in which the "R" stands for **RESPECTING OTHERS**.

Jesus tells us, "in everything, do to others as you would have them do to you, for this is the law and the prophets" (Matthew 7:12). He learned those words from the teachings of the Bible as a child himself, and urges us to remember them. Sadly, it is often more difficult for us as adults, as we learn to separate people by color or ethnicity or national origin or any of a number of other possible differences, to remember as easily as our children do that we are called to treat others as we would like to be treated. If we are going truly to respect others, we need to recognize and honor who they are and, at the same time, recognize the dignity inherent in each human being and "do" accordingly.
