We are excited to be back worshiping together again, especially during Holy Week. Prince of Peace will be worshiping in-person together on Easter Sunday, meaning we will offer online only services for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. Prince of Peace continues to follow all health guidelines directed by our Governor and The Ohio Department of Health. Please keep in mind that Cuyahoga County and our surrounding counties are still in the Red Zone. As the county continues to recover, the mask mandate placed on July 17th, and reinstated on Nov. 12th will still be in effect.

#### **RESERVATIONS:**

Prince of Peace's top priority is to create a safe and comfortable environment for members and friends to worship in. If you feel comfortable, please sign-up to worship with us for our **Easter services on April 4th**. We will be worshiping together at Prince of Peace at 9am and 11am. We will also be having an outdoor, socially-distanced social hour in-between services with coffee. Our at-risk members are still encouraged to participate through digital worship until they are comfortable worshiping in-person. There will be a limited number of "family groups" in the sanctuary so we can maintain social-distancing (a family group is 1 to 5 people). As more is known about the health and safety considerations, we will adjust our worship opportunities.

#### The Color of Love

During November, 2020 I received a call from by brother in Christ, Terry, a friend of mine at the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. He also works with the Catholic Church, Our Lady of Fatima, in one of the poorest sections of Cleveland. They were continuing a program of handing out hams to poor families at Christmas. Their program is called the Ham Jam, but they were also in need of clothing and blankets. He asked if our church could help. I thought of the many wonderful and colorful quilts made by our Prince of Peace Quilting group. I contacted Becky Wagoner and asked if the group had any quilts they could donate. I put her in touch with Terry and the rest is history, as they say,



Becky gave them over twenty colorful quilts. I asked Terry if he could share any of the results or tell us of the impact of these gifts. Well, here is the rest of the story. Toni Smith, who is Athletic Director of the Fatima Sports Program mentioned the following three families in particular.

Miss Althea Clark heard about the quilts prior to the Ham Jam, and she couldn't wait to see them. She was hoping they were not just plain color blankets. When she saw these wonderful, colorful blankets and the many choices she was visibly elated. She so wanted something pretty for her modest home.

Miss Nanny Sanders is 98 years old, and lives in the Cleveland housing projects. When she heard about the program, she asked for one ham and one blanket. Toni Smith said she delivered the blanket and ham to her. But her grandson also needed a blanket, so she gave her two. As she handed her the blankets, Miss Nanny held back tears. Toni said that Miss Nanny Sanders is like a mother to her. She said that these two blankets were like gold for her, as they were going to keep family members warm.

Elva and Cleveland Norman had lived next door to the person who ran the Our Lady of Fatima Mission Center. The wonderful Normans are now deceased, but their family now lives in the home. When a member of the family heard about the Ham Jam, she asked if they had any blankets for her children. They had no blankets and were sleeping in their clothes, jackets, gloves and socks to keep warm. Toni Smith handed this mother three blankets. Toni said she thought the lady was going to pass out from joy. These three blankets made their Christmas, because now the children could take off their jackets for bedtime.

My friend, Terry, said, "Dick, you can't make this up. The poverty right here in Cleveland is indescribable." My friends at Prince of Peace, many times we don't know how our gifts and mission dollars touch other lives in positive ways. With the gifts of these colorful quilts, we have a small peak into the positive impact of giving, showing that love truly has color. Thank you to those who worked on the quilts, and those who helped financially in any way for making this past Christmas a little warmer and more colorful.
