Come pick-up an Ash Wednesday at-home ashes kit! Dineen and Megan will have kit's put together for families, so you can practice the Imposition of ashes on Ash Wednesday, at home. The kits will include ashes, communion, and an instruction card on how to use the ashes properly.



If you are unable to stop by between the times, we will have some available to pick up in the office on Monday, February 15th between 10:00 am - 3:00 pm, or there will be kits set out to be taken by the west-side door inside the wooden chest.

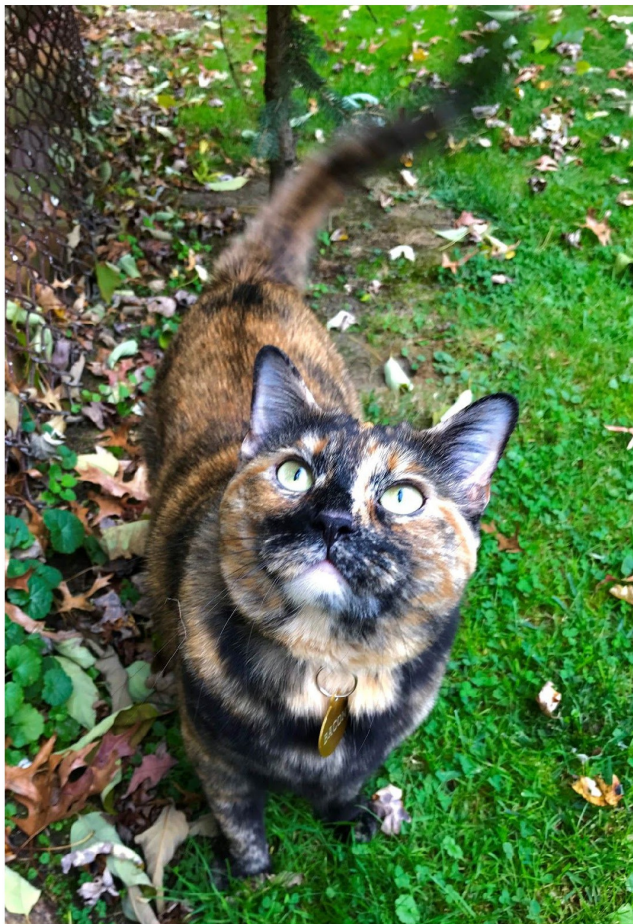
