

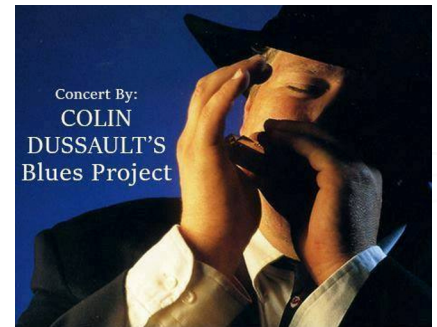


## Bluz Over Africa
